Brighton Green Pool Rules:

- 1) No running on pool deck.
 - The rule when patrons play “Apple tree” and “Cross Pool” is they are not allowed to start running past the first crevice in the pool deck
- 2) No smoking inside pool area.
- 3) No drugs in pool area.
- 4) No food inside pool area.
- 5) No glass inside pool area.
- 6) Alcoholic beverages must be in unmarked/non-glass containers. Management reserves the right to deny swimming privileges to those deemed intoxicated.
- 7) No stereos without the use of headphones.
- 8) No jumping backwards off side of the pool.
- 9) No flips off side of pool.
- 10) No hanging on the basketball rim/hoop.
- 11) No sitting or standing on another person’s shoulders.
- 12) No horseplay, including: pushing, dunking, chicken fighting, etc.
- 13) No masks or goggles covering the nose.
- 14) No snorkels or fins (fins and other appropriate equipment is allowed for lap swimming in designated lanes only).
- 15) No flotation devices including water wings, life vests, noodles, kickboards, inflatable rings etc. Bathing suits with floats built-in to the suit ARE allowed.
- 16) No water guns/squirt guns.
- 17) No diving STICKS allowed. Diving RINGS are allowed.
- 18) No diving in the 2- foot area.

- 19) No riding the vent in the well.
- 20) No chairs or other furniture is allowed in the pool at any time.

21) **SLIDE RULES**

- a) Only one person is allowed on the slide AT ALL TIMES.
 - b) Patrons can either go down the slide on their backs, feet first or one their stomach, head first.
 - c) Patrons must wait at the bottom of the ladder until the person in front of them has gone down the slide.
 - d) Patrons must check to make sure the area under the slide is clear of other swimmers BEFORE sliding down.
 - e) Patrons must clear the area at the bottom of the slide IMMEDIATELY after sliding down.
- 22) No foul language/no profanity is tolerated ... no exceptions.
 - 23) Pets are not permitted within pool area.

24) **GUEST POLICIES**

- a) Members must pay the guest fee for each guest using the pool.
 - b) The fee is waived for children 2 years old and younger and those not swimming.
 - c) Members are responsible for their guests and MUST stay with them for the duration of their time at the pool.
 - d) Guest fees cover the entire day.
- 25) All patrons must wear appropriate swimwear. No thongs, cutoffs, undergarments, or street clothing.
 - 26) Riding skateboards, scooters, and bicycles on paths, walkways, tennis courts, and within pool area is not permitted.
 - 27) A parent or someone 16 or older must accompany children younger than 10 years of age; otherwise they will be denied admittance.
 - 28) Children 10 and older may attend the pool unaccompanied by an adult if they are qualified swimmers and display maturity in abiding pool rules.
 - 29) Starting blocks are reserved for swim team use only. No diving or jumping from blocks during regular pool hours.

30) Adults attending to non-swimmers are responsible for keeping them from the deep-end and they are responsible for watching non-swimmers in their at all times. Patrons should CAUTION children that water is 5 feet deep near the slides.

31) ADULT SWIM

- a) Adult swim will take place the last 15 minutes of every hour, except for the first and last hours of operation.
- b) During this time, all patrons under the age of 18 must exit the pool.
- c) Lifeguards may permit swim team members to swim laps. This is left to the discretion of the lifeguard and swimmers must gain approval prior to entering the pool. If there are many adults in the pool then refrain from allowing the kids to swim.
- d) NO BALL THROWING across the main pool is allowed during adult swim.

32) No children over the age of 5 are allowed in the baby pool.

33) Children still in diapers must wear appropriate swimming diapers and a swimsuit.

34) INCLEMENT WEATHER POLICIES:

- a) Thunder- pool closes for 20 minutes and the pool area must be cleared.
- b) Lightening- pool closes for 30 minutes and pool area must be cleared.
- c) Rain- heavy rain (whereby lifeguards cannot see the bottom of the pool) will cause the pool to close.
- d) Inclement weather after 6:00 PM will cause the pool to close for the remainder of the day.

35) Any person who refuses to adhere to facility rules and continues unsafe behavior will be instructed to leave by a lifeguard, manager, or Brighton Green Board Member.

- 36) The pool will be used only during scheduled hours when lifeguards are on duty. Failure to comply will result in suspension or loss of membership.
- 37) Those found abusing association property are subject to arrest and or prosecution. Parents are liable for damages for which their juvenile children are responsible.
- 38) The association is not responsible for injuries or valuables. Lifeguards/ employees are not permitted to hold anyone's personal belongings/ valuables.
- 39) The pool manager, staff, or Brighton Green Community Association Board members may adjust these rules at any time.

40) FLOAT NIGHT RULES

All of the regular pool rules are in effect with the following exceptions:

- a) Floats are allowed but no jumping from the side of the pool onto the floats.

b) SLIDE RULES:

- i) One person on the slide at a time
- ii) Patrons can go down two different slides at the same time however.
- iii) Patrons may NOT go down onto a float.
- iv) Patrons may NOT go down ON a float.
- v) Fins are allowed.
- vi) NO water guns!
- vii) Use of blocks is allowed.

Note: On days when there is a swim meet schedule at BG, all recreational members are allowed to swim at any other RMAL member pool. There is no charge for this service but you MUST present your BG membership number.

**DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS FOR VIOLATION OF
POOL RULES:**

In the event any of the above mentioned rules are violated, the lifeguard has the authority to enact the following disciplinary measures:

1st Offense: Verbal Warning

2nd Offense: Patron must sit out of pool for an appropriate amount of time deemed by the lifeguard.

(Usually it's however old they are is how many minutes you sit them out for)

3rd Offense: Patron will lose their pool privileges for the rest of the day.

- *Always seek assistance from a head guard with discipline*
