

## **FAQ for Brighton Green Membership and Pool:**

**A general membership (\$65) comes with 5 pool passes, right? Does this mean my family can go five times?**

The five pool passes are per person. This means that 5 people can come once. If you have a family of 3, for instance, you all can come once and then two of you can come again.

**I haven't received my pool pass in the mail – where can I pick it up?**

Pool passes will be located at the lifeguard stand down at the pool and will remain there for the season.

**Can I pay for my membership in installments?**

All memberships must be paid for in one payment. If you get your membership in before the early bird deadline (April 15, 2015), you get \$30 off the price!

**We are going out of town for all of August – can I purchase a membership just for June and July?**

We only offer memberships for the entire pool season, sorry!

**Can a guest of mine come by himself/herself when I'm not around?**

All guest passes must be purchased by members, and the member must accompany guests to the pool.

**I babysit some kids during the summer – can they come to the pool on my membership?**

For non-dependent children, you will have to purchase guest passes so that they can come with you to the pool.

**What if we have three or more adults in our household – can we all be on one family membership?**

A family membership is only for two adults per household – male, female, whoever –but only two. Any additional adults in a household must purchase their own membership.

**I have some family coming in town for a week in August – can they come to the pool on my membership?**

They can't come to the pool on your membership, but we do offer a one-week family pass! It's a great deal for families in this situation and they can come as your guests.
