

## **FAQs for Brighton Green Membership and Pool:**

**A general membership (\$80.00) come with 5 pool passes. Does this mean that my family can go five times?**

The five pool passes are per person. This means that five people can come at once. If you have a family of three, for instance, you can all come once, then two of you can come again.

**I haven't received my pool pass in the mail—where can I pick it up?**

Pool passes will be located at the lifeguard stand at the pool, and will remain there for the season.

**Can I pay for my membership in installments?**

There is a payment installment option on the membership application.

**We will be out of town for all of August. Can I purchase a membership for just June and July?**

We only offer memberships for the entire season.

**Can a guest of mine come by himself or herself when I'm not around?**

All guest passes must be purchased by members, and the member must accompany guests to the pool.

**I provide child card for children during the summer. Can those children come to the pool on my membership?**

For non-dependent children, you will have to purchase guest passes so they can come with you to the pool. There are several good options for non-members in the Membership Add-On portion of the Membership Dues and Fee Schedule.

**What if we have three or more adults in our household? Can we all be on one family membership?**

A family membership is only for two adults per household. Any additional adults beyond that must purchase their own memberships.

**I have some family visiting in August. Can they come to the pool on my membership?**

They cannot come to the pool using your membership, but we do offer a Weekly Non-Member Pass, and a Daily Pool Pass, in the Membership Add-On portion of the Membership Dues and Fee Schedule.
